Thank you to everyone who completed our recent survey about after-school wraparound care at our nursery. We were delighted with the strong response and the helpful feedback provided.

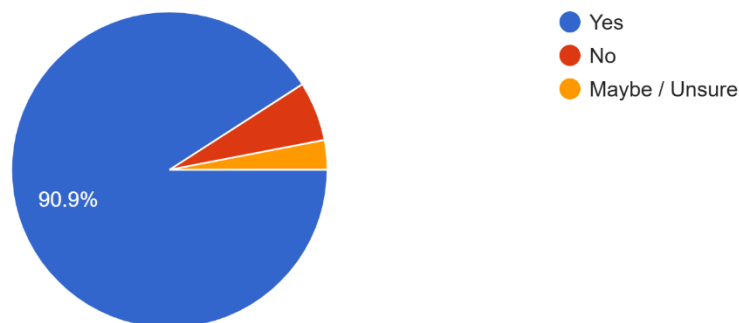
SUMMARY HEADLINES

- Almost all families (30 out of 33) said they would be interested in using wraparound care.
- Most parents indicated they would use the service regularly, with the majority saying 4–5 days per week.
- The most popular times were 3:30–6:00 pm and 3:30–5:30 pm.
- Families preferred termly booking arrangements.
- The activities you most want to see included are outdoor play, music and movement, arts and crafts, and reading/story time.

We are now exploring how to shape the provision to best meet these needs and will keep you updated with next steps.

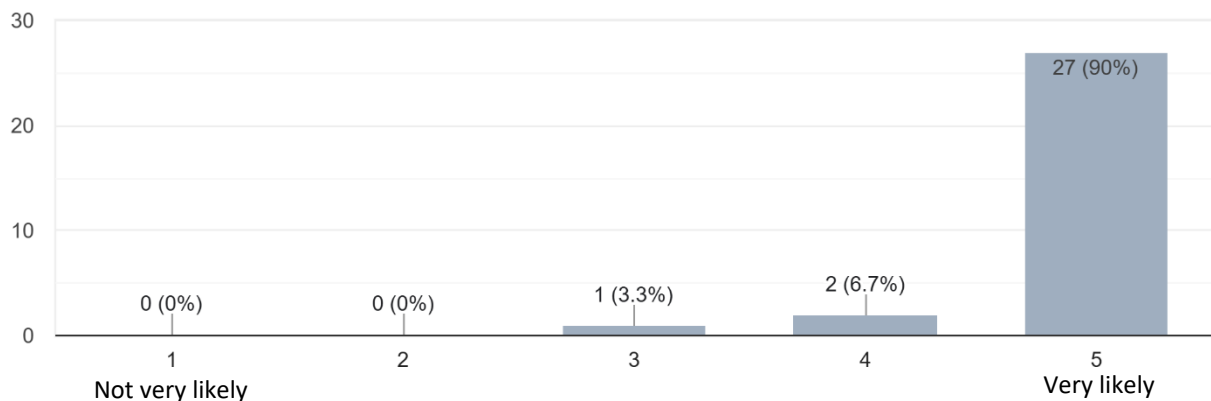
Would you be interested in after-school wraparound care for your child at our nursery?

If yes, how likely would you be to use this service? If no, please skip this question.

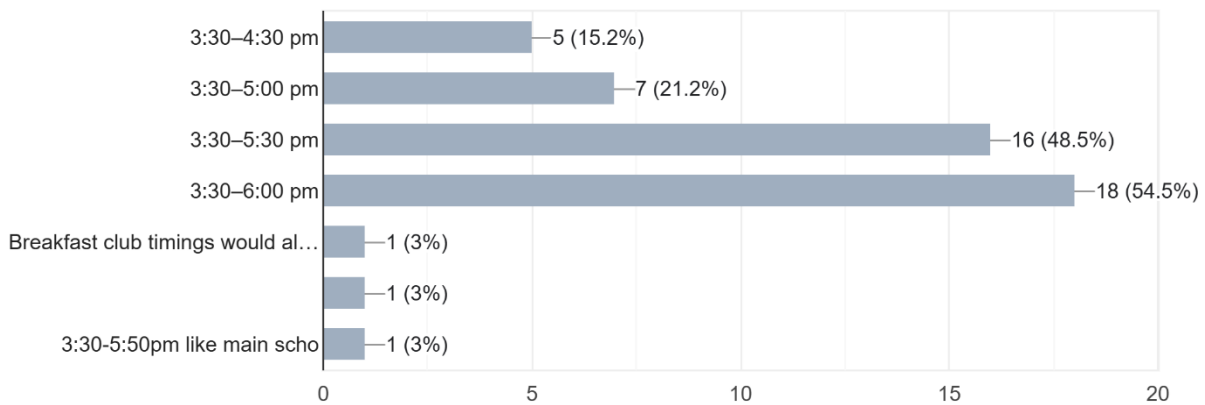

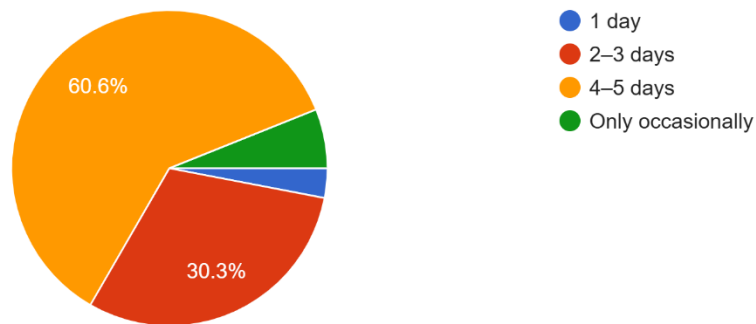
What times would be most useful for after-school care? (select all that apply)

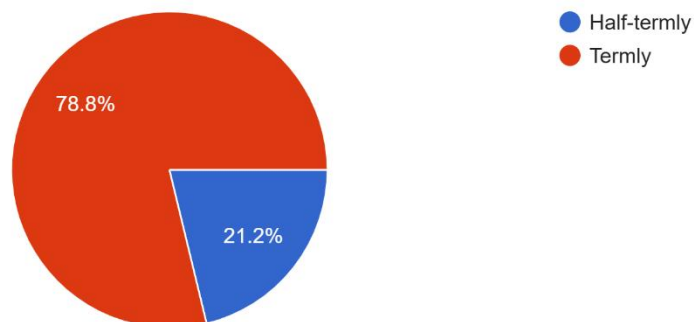
How many days per week do you think you would need wraparound care?

For booking a place, which booking frequency would work best?

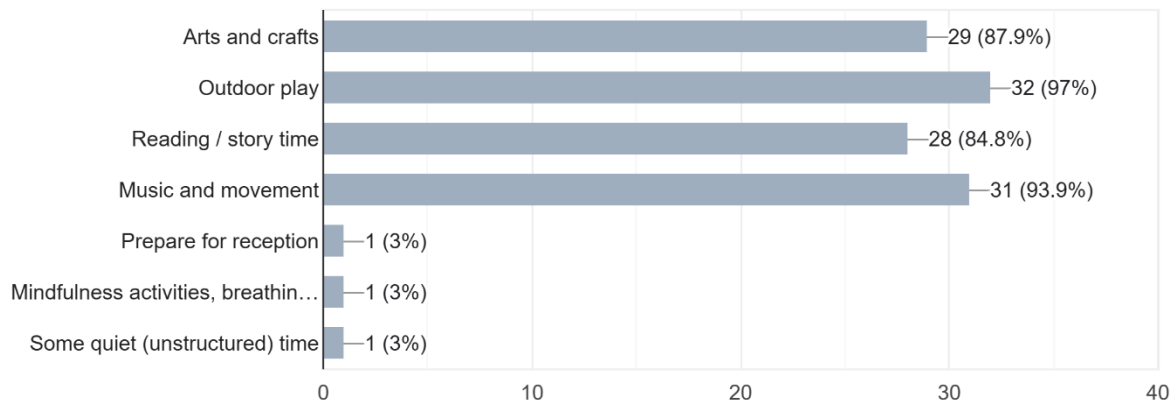

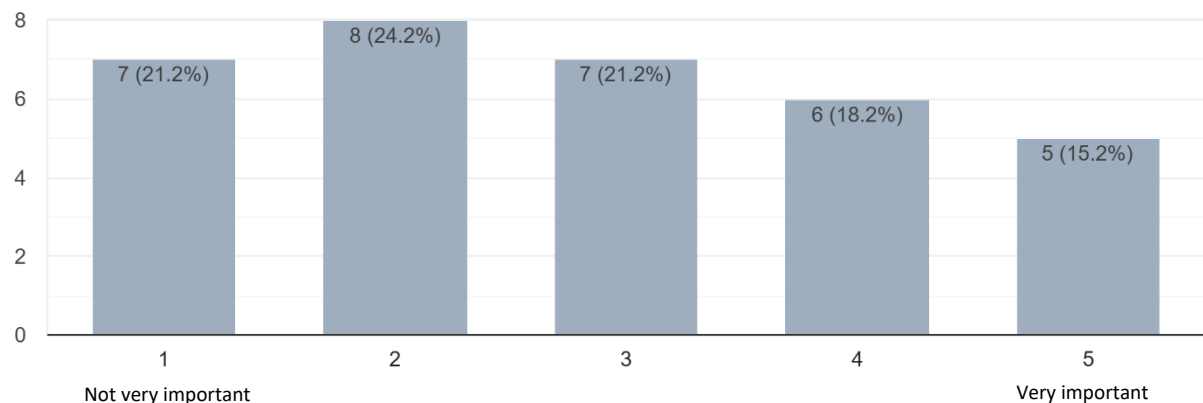
What types of activities would you like to see included in wraparound care? (select all that apply)

Just to say that the reason I haven't put my daughter in nursery was because there was no option of wraparound care. I know that this was mentioned by a few parents who also felt the same. There is definitely an appetite for it.

The most helpful for us as parents would be if the timings could closely match those for older siblings - we would love to be able to send our son to St Luke's nursery but could only do so if he could be there between 7:45am and 5pm

Needs to have the same hours as the usual after school club.

Tea offering



The sole reason we have not moved our child to nursery is the lack of wrap around care that I can access if we did. Esp with an older child who can access it, it becomes overly complex. Our family would be so grateful for wrap around care. It's been our main concern when making the decision for my return to work.

We are considering St Luke's for our (currently 2 year old) daughter. She is at Katey's but we feel that 2 years in their pre-school is too long. Lack of wraparound care has been our concern as we both work so this option really opens this up as a great solution.

The only reason we don't use the nursery at StL, is due to the fact there is no wrap around care, which means we go to a different nursery.

Our youngest does not currently attend St Luke's, and we chose not to apply for a nursery place due to the lack of wraparound care. A 3:30 pickup would present logistical challenges for our family due to work. However, should wraparound provision become available in the future, we would be keen to apply.

It would be incredibly helpful to have wraparound care. Currently we haven't really considered applying for a nursery place for our youngest son because of our full time work commitments.

Do you have any concerns or suggestions about after-school care at our nursery?

Safety / prefer not to watch TV screen during the wraparound care time

I would like to know if the kids are going to be mixed with older kids?

Helpful if it can be aligned to main school for those with siblings

Would they be mixing with older children at Lookout Club? Would they be having the same snacks and screen time?

No - we appreciate the will to engage in ASC. We would love for Louie and I know many other parents that would love for their child to attend the pre-school at St Luke's but unable to due the wrap around care. I personally have had to decline the last 2 successful applications due to these reasons. Many of the local schools offer the ASC service for pre-school.

Please do try to introduce this as we would love to avail of the school nursery, particularly for siblings.
